•	PERSONAL ACCIDENT
	If someone requires medical attention, and a driver is available, take the patient
	immediately to the Accident & Emergency Department of

	If not ring or 999 and ask for an ambulance.
•	SMELL OF GAS
	Ring British Gas immediately on
•	WATER LEAK
	Please contact the contracted plumbing service on
•	FIRE ALARM ACTIVATION
	If the fire alarm activates, the fire evacuation procedure must be adopted. The
	nominated volunteer in charge must ensure all personnel are accounted for and leave
	the area promptly. You must not return until the Fire Brigade authorise you to. If the
	fire is small, and without endangering your own life, you may wish to attempt to put out
	the fire with the fire extinguishers provided. YOU ARE NOT OBLIGED TO ATTEMPT THIS
	IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO. ENSURE AT ALL TIMES YOUR EXIT IS CLEAR.
•	AIR CONDITIONING EMERGENCY
	Please callfor assistance.
•	UNAUTHORISED PERSONNEL ON SITE OR IN THE BUILDING

•	SECURITY
	The building/area should not be left empty and unlocked/disarmed at any time. The
