We have an exciting opportunity for a paediatric dietitian with expertise in coeliac disease and gluten related conditions to join our Health Advisory Council (HAC). As a member of Coeliac UK's HAC you will provide the Charity with expert insight into any health related issues, associated research and advice on relevant policies and activities. Role description

Membership of HAC includes representation from a range of professions including dietetics, general practice, paediatrics, gastroenterology and clinical psychology. This ensures that all aspects of healthcare and management including medical management (primary and secondary), dietary management, psycho-social understanding and health economics are covered.

HAC advises the Board of Governors on scientific and health issues. HAC operates virtually throughout the year and meets twice a year usually in June and November. These meetings take place either virtually via Zoom or face to face in London.

Terms of appointment for HAC members will be three years with the possibility of renewal depending on mutual agreement.
