Group Organisers Report: The Dartmoor Picnic took place but only 6 people (4 with Coeliac) turned up on a very wet windy day. The letter-boxing has been very successful and finishes at the end of Oct when new walks tend to be published. Thanks to RJ.

Treasurer's Report: The Meet-Ups continue to be self-funding.

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

Newsletter: This was felt to be a worthwhile endeavour to help to inform the membership about the activities undertaken by the committee over the past year. There still seems to be a disappointing lack of engagement with the membership. It appears that this is a common issue for many groups (volunteering lounge sessions).

We discussed the possibility of sending out a questionnaire to the membership to seek ways of improving our interface e.g. what sort of things would you like the committee to consider? would you like to be involved?. This will be discussed at the next meeting.

Meet-Ups: We agreed that this term would be used from now, in keeping with Coeliac UK terminology. **Honiton Meet-Up**: 15 people at the last one including 2 new members. Honiton uses a more personal touch using individual emails with permission from the Meet-Up user. LH reported that the venue will now change. Tavistock Meet-Up: The first one has taken place – with 2 members attending. This is less easy to publicise as the postcodes for our group do not include all those relevant to the Tavistock area.
