Local Group Membership Survey

Thank you to the 116 people who completed our survey. This was a great response as it gives us a clear indication of what you, our members, want from us.

Here is a brief overview of the results:

- 80% of respondents receive our newsletter and a further 20 people asked to be added to the distribution list.
- 90% of those who receive it, read our newsletter and 98% of those people find it informative.
- Only 18% of you have attended one of our events as 53% of people said the dates didn't suit. However, 16% said they were nervous about attending and 31% said they probably wouldn't attend an in-person event.
- The event most people said they would attend is coffee and cake, a meal out was the next most popular option. Other suggestions were: drinks at a local pub, a Christmas get together, a bbq or picnic, bowling, and a children's event.
- There was a real mixture of the times you would prefer (weekday evening 32%, weekday daytime 29%, weekend daytime 25%, and weekend evening 14%)

We currently have 475 people on our mailing list and over 500 members of our Facebook group so it's important to us that we provide support for everyone. We're not just here for those who have been diagnosed with Coeliac disease. We also support those people who need a gluten free diet but don't have a formal diagnosis. If you know someone who is thinking about being tested, or maybe just has symptoms and isn't sure, let them know they are welcome to come along to one of our events and talk to us. We also welcome family and friends of anyone who needs to eat gluten free and can provide advice and support to them, too.
