## **Glutafin Cookery Demonstration**

In December around 50 members and their guests enjoyed a Cookery Demonstration undertaken by Steph Clubb, Home Economist of Glutafin in the St James Road Methodist Church Hall in Shirley. Members received a copy of Glutafin's latest recipe book "Delicious Dishes" which includes four of the recipes demonstrated by Steph, Sweet pastry made into mince pies, Scones with sun-dried tomatoes, Pork Pie and Pasta Shells with cheese cubes and mixed olives. Samples of all the recipes were available for members to try at the end of the demonstration.
